

According to [National Autism Resources Website](#) :

Sensory Rooms are now common in schools, hospitals and community centers. These rooms use sensory equipment to create a controlled sensory-focused environment. These environments allow sensory experiences to be individually tailored to meet the specific needs of an individual.

This project is in its very early working stage. A room has been set aside by Willamette Elementary School and Sensory Room items are being acquired every day.

The students in Jerod Harney's class from Patton Middle School enjoying their new EZY rollers.


Mr. Harney received an Educators grant for the EZY Riders from TLF.
